Asia, Australia, Canada, North America, South America, Central America, Africa, the Caribbean, Europe or Louisiana.

1. Submit your original typed recipe by 5:00 PM Friday, October 16.
(See required recipe format).
2. You will be contacted if your entry is accepted.
3. If accepted, bring TWO presentations of your dish (one for judging, one for display & sampling) to the LA State Museum, 660 N. 4th St. on Sunday, November 1 at 4:30 PM.
4. Dishes are judged by a panel of Baton Rouge celebrities with special consideration given to: **Presentation, Originality, Complexity & Flavor**
5. 1st and 2nd prizes are presented in these categories: **Appetizers • Entrees • Desserts**
6. Student Entries (through age 18): 1st prize is presented in these categories: **Appetizers • Entrees • Desserts**
7. All submitted recipes become the property of the Baton Rouge Center for World Affairs, Inc. – allowing for publication of recipes, name and photo of contestant.

RECIPE FORMAT

Type and submit recipe as follows:

- ❖ Recipe name
- ❖ Country of origin
- ❖ Description of dish, what makes it unique to its place of origin
- ❖ Ingredients with amounts and preparation instructions including oven temp and cooking time
- ❖ Number of servings

Print or type on the recipe: Category entered, your name, mailing address, phone and, if available, and e-mail address.

If you are entering as a **Student**: please write STUDENT and your age after your name. Student Category is open up through age 18. **Parents**: attach your written permission to recipe entry.

All accepted entrants admitted free to the event.
