- If you have other needs such as electricity (110 only) we may be able to help. Access to power is limited.

THE VENDOR WILL SUPPLY:

- **10'X10' Tent or BRCWA can supply you a 10'x10' tent for an additional \$175.**
- **Merchandise List** of what you plan to sell. **Send list to BRCWA by March 22 to meet our program deadline.** (see contact info at right to return form) You will be part of our International Bazaar featuring high quality ethnic craft items such as baskets, textiles and decorative objects. You may also sell CDs and books relating to world cultures.
No ready-to-eat food or drink may be sold.
- **Tables, Chairs & Table Coverings** (cloth to cover your tables).

SUGGESTIONS TO ENHANCE YOUR SITE:

- Vendors are encouraged to wear native clothing and to decorate tables with flags and pictures. You may also play native music at low volume. We encourage you to hand out flyers, coupons, directions and any information you wish to promote your store.

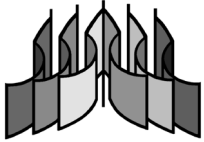
